## INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on April 6, 2010, the Grand

Jurors of Charleston County present upon their oath:

## BREACH OF TRUST WITH FRAUDULENT INTENT

That Lucas L. Ulmer did in Charleston County beginning on or about April 3, 2008, to on or about June 3, 2008, having been entrusted by Linda Jones with the care, keeping and possession of certain personal property valued at more than Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000), did breach this trust by converting and appropriating such property to his own use and purpose, with the fraudulent intent to permanently deprive the owner thereof, to wit:

Lucas L. Ulmer was entrusted by Linda Jones with \$50,000 for the purpose of ROTLEDGE With \$50,000 for the purpose of purchasing property located at 114 Charleston Avenue; however, in breach of this trust, Lucas L. Ulmer did convert over Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000) entrusted to him by Linda Jones to his own use, all in violation of §16-30-230(B)(3) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976), as amended.
