## **Sex Offender Arrested for Criminal Sexual Solicitation and Dissemination of Obscene Material to a Minor Charges**

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Danny Wayne Long (DOB: 1967) of Piedmont, S.C. for two charges in connection with the criminal solicitation of a minor. The Greenville County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Attorney General's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest.

Investigators say Long solicited sex from someone he believed to be a minor. The minor was actually an undercover officer working with the Greenville County Sheriff's Office. During the course of the investigation, Long also disseminated obscene material to the undercover officer.

Long was previously convicted in 2010 for similar charges stemming from a 2009 arrest by the Laurens County Sheriff's Office, also an ICAC Task Force member.

In this instance, Long was arrested on July 14, 2015. He is charged with one (1) count of Criminal Solicitation of a Minor (§16-15-342) and one (1) count of Dissemination of Obscene Material, (§16-15-345), both felony offenses punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
