Florence Man Arrested on Dissemination of Obscene Material to a Minor Charge

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Willis Grover (DOB: 1984) of Florence, South Carolina on one (1) charge connected to the dissemination of obscene material to minors. The Florence County Sheriff's Office, a member of the state's Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest.

Grover sent the victim a sexually explicit photo. He was arrested on August 21, 2015. Grover is charged with one (1) count of Dissemination of Obscene Material to a Minor 12 Years or Younger, (§16-15-355), a felony offense punishable by up to fifteen (15) years imprisonment.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
