By your letter of June 14, 1984, you have asked this Office for its opinion as to the constitutionality of H.3936-R 529, which bill sets the tax millage rates for six public service or special purpose districts in Charleston County. It has been, and continues to be, the opinion of this Office that the above-cited bill is most probably unconstitutional. For further discussion of the matter, I refer you to opinions of this Office dated June 7, 1983-January 6, 1983; June 2, 1983, with enclosure dated June 6, 1980; and June 14, 1982, copies of which are enclosed.
