You have requested information as to whether, if York County were to create a county mental retardation board pursuant to Act No. 1127 of 1974 (§§ 44-21-810 et seq.), the county board would be a political subdivision of the State or an integral part of the County.

I enclose a copy of an opinion dated January 8, 1979, in which it was concluded that a similar board created under the same statute was a political subdivision. The same result would apply in the case of the proposed York County board.
