Dear Representative Middleton:

This letter will confirm your earlier telephone conversation with Treva Ashworth of my Office regarding your recent letter addressed to me. You had stated in your letter that the Orangeburg County Board of Registration had requested various changes be made in the description of the precinct lines in Orangeburg County.

As Ms. Ashworth discussed with you in your telephone conversation, these changes would have to be accomplished through legislative action of the General Assembly. SOUTH CAROLINA CODE OF LAWS, 1976, as amended, Section 7-7-10. Any change would then have to be submitted to the United States Department of Justice for their review under the Voting Rights Act.

The changes appear to be noncontroversial changes to correct certain inaccuracies as to the precinct line description and would presumably not be found objectionable by the Justice Department.
