Dear Governor Riley:

In response to your request for an opinion from my Office as to the constitutionality of an act of the General Assembly amending a 1973 act, as amended, so as to provide for Charleston County's share of the 1980-81 operating expenses of the Berkeley-Charleston-Dorchester Technical Education Center, it is my opinion that such legislation is most probably constitutional and violates neither Article VIII, Section 7 nor Article III, Section 34, subdivision ix of the South Carolina Constitution because it relates to education. See, [Moye v. Caughman, 217 S.E.2d 36 \(1975\)](#).
