Dear Senator Setzler:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to whether or not a person who operates a travel agency and who has a municipal business license must also have a broker's license, I know of no statutory requirement that a travel agent possess a broker's license or, indeed, of any statutory regulation of travel agents or agencies. Cf., §§ 37-201 et seq., §§ 56-1545 et seq., CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA, 1962, as amended.
