Dear Mrs. Dreyfus:

You have inquired with respect to the procedure for the imposition of taxes for the School District of Greenville County.

I advise that the General Assembly may fix the millage for taxes in the School District at whatever amount it desires and that no election or referendum within the District is necessary for such action by the General Assembly.

If it so desires, the School District may conduct a referendum to increase the amount established by the General Assembly.
