Dear Mrs. Fielder:

I have examined the resolutions which accompany your letter of April 22, 1977, and see no legal objection to the validity of those resolutions with one exception: the copy of the Resolution of the Beaufort Housing Authority is unsigned. By copy of this letter, I am notifying Mr. Harold Branton of this minor oversight.

With respect to your second question, concerning the validity of the creation of an executive committee for the Beaufort City Housing Authority, I am aware of no barrier to the creation of such a committee. However, this matter concerns the internal affairs of the City, County, and Housing Authority. Since the duties of the State Development Board with respect to housing authorities are primarily directed to insuring that county, local and regional housing authorities do not have overlapping or conflicting jurisdiction, it is unnecessary for the Board to consider the validity of an executive committee.

I apologize for my delay in preparing this brief response.
