Dear Mrs. Craig:

Mr. Collins has written this Office concerning your request for retirement credit for the time during which you were employed by the Tuberculosis Association. Unfortunately, I must concur with the statement of Mr. Collins that the Tuberculosis Association does not meet the statutory definition of an 'employer' for Retirement System purposes. Moreover, the Retirement System lacks the authority to treat a private organization as if it were such an employer, even under such extenuating circumstances as your case presents.

I deeply regret that this Office's opinion must be contrary to your interests in this matter.
