Dear Mr. Williams:

In reply to your letter dated August 13, 1977, this is to advise that, as far as I am personally aware, there is no printed form for either a coroner's warrant or a coroner's commitment.

For your use, I am enclosing a machine copy of a rather dated coroner's handbook which I drafted some years ago. Most of the law set out therein is probably still good; however, we no longer use the 1962 Code. The latter's section numbers, nonetheless, may be transposed. See, Vol. 22, Code of Laws of South Carolina Statutory Tables at 284-285 (1976).
