You have requested advice as to the propriety of the Arts Commission using the bulk mail permit of an incorporated nonprofit corporation which carries on some of the Commission's work. It is my opinion that this procedure is so likely to be improper that it should not be followed. However, there would appear to be no reason why the Commission could not secure a permit itself for appropriate mailings.
