Spartanburg Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Robert Kevin Alley (DOB: 1966) of Spartanburg, S.C., on fourteen (14) charges connected to sexual exploitation of minors. Investigators with the South Carolina Attorney General's Office made the arrest. The Department of Homeland Security, South Carolina Department of Public Safety and the Spartanburg County Sheriff's Office, all members of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, assisted in the arrest. The City of Rock Hill Police Department, also a member of the ICAC Task Force, assisted in the investigation.

Investigators state that Alley was involved in downloading child pornography via a file-sharing network.

Alley was arrested on April 13, 2016. He is charged with four (4) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Second Degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to (10) years imprisonment on each count; and with ten (10) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Third Degree (§16-15-410), a felony offense punishable by up to ten (10) years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
