Cheraw Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Leon Bobby Jones-Hubbard (DOB: 1993) of Cheraw, S.C., on four (4) charges connected to sexual exploitation of minors. Investigators with the South Carolina Attorney General's Office made the arrest. The Chesterfield County Sheriff's Office and the Town of Cheraw Police Department, both members of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, assisted in the arrest. The Charlotte-Mecklenburg Police Department assisted in the investigation.

Investigators state that Jones-Hubbard was involved in distributing sexually explicit images of a minor via a file-sharing network.

Jones-Hubbard was arrested on May 25, 2016. He is charged with four (4) counts of Sexual Exploitation of a Minor, Second Degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to (10) years imprisonment.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
