Lexington Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charge

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest of Jereme Michael Bowman (DOB: 3/30/1989) of Lexington, S.C., on 1 charge connected to sexual exploitation of a minor. The Lexington County Sheriff's Office, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force made the arrest. Investigators with the Attorney General's Office assisted with the investigation.

Investigators state that Bowman was involved in downloading and distributing child pornography via the Internet.

Bowman was arrested on Jan. 25, 2017. He is charged with 1 count Sexual Exploitation of a Minor Second Degree (§16-15-405) a felony offense punishable by up to 10 years imprisonment.

The case will be prosecuted by the Attorney General's Office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
