Seneca Man Arrested on Child Pornography Charges

(COLUMBIA, S.C.) South Carolina Attorney General Alan Wilson announced the arrest Aaron Scott Evans (DOB: 7/30/1974) of Seneca, S.C., on three charges connected to sexual exploitation of a minor. The Seneca Police Department, a member of the Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force, made the arrest. Investigators with the attorney general's office assisted with the investigation.

Investigators state that Evans was involved in distributing child pornography via the Internet.

Evans was arrested on March 10, 2017. He is charged with three counts of sexual exploitation of a minor second degree (§16-15-405), a felony offense punishable by up to 10 years imprisonment on each count.

The case will be prosecuted by the attorney general's office.

Attorney General Wilson stressed all defendants are presumed innocent unless and until they are proven guilty in a court of law.
