Dear Mr. Clinkscales:

You have inquired as to the residential requirements to become a candidate for the office of House of Representatives.

The only requirement which is imposed is that you be a qualified elector, i.e., that you be registered as a voter in the district from which you seek election. To be registered as a voter, you must, of course, be a resident. I would suggest that if you consider yourself a resident of the district, you apply for registration at the board of registration and obtain a voter registration certificate. This certificate entitles you to run for office in that district, specifically for the House of Representatives.
