The Laurens County Board of Voter Registration consists of five members, South Carolina Code of Laws, Section 23-51.7, 1962, as amended, who are appointed by the Governor by and with the advice and consent of the Senate between January 1 and March 15 in every even numbered year. The members are subject to removal by the Governor who is also authorized to fill all vacancies. A term of office on the Board is two years; however, they shall continue in office until their successors shall have been appointed and shall qualify. South Carolina Code of Laws, Sections 23-51 and 52, 1962, as amended. The 'Home Rule Act' does not affect this Board, South Carolina Code of Laws, Section 14-3714, 1962, as amended.
