Your letter of April 15, 1976, requesting contractual agreements which the State has with various architectural and engineering firms with regard to the E-A's supplying sufficient copies of documents for bidding as well as for construction, has been referred by Mr. McLeod to me for answer. The State does not have a standard agreement between E-A's and the various State agencies using their services. Generally, the individual agencies use the standard AIA contract form.
