Dear Senator Saleeby:

I advise that Section 47-1541 of the 1962 Code of Laws, which vested certain lands in the City of Charleston, has been repealed by the provisions of Act No. 283 of 1975 (the Home Rule Act) by Section 5 thereof which provides: 'The 1962 Code is amended by striking Articles 1, 3, 4 and 5 of Chapter 1, Chapters 2 through 7, and Chapter 14, all of Title 47, and inserting in lieu thereof the following:—.'

This Act was approved by the Governor on the 25th day of June, 1975, and became effective immediately thereupon.
