Dear Mr. Collins:

You have requested an opinion as to the legal status of the Oconee County Sewer Commission, and whether it is an 'employer' within the meaning of South Carolina Code of Laws § 9-1-10(5).

Although the Commission was originally created by statute in 1971, its functions will be assumed by Oconee County on January 1, 1980, pursuant to a County Ordinance and to the Home Rule Act (see editor's note to § 4-9-10). On the basis of the foregoing, it is the opinion of this Office that the Oconee County Sewer Commission is an integral part of the county.
