Dear Mr. Mikell:

You have inquired whether a foreign professional corporation may be domesticated under the laws of South Carolina governing domestication of foreign corporations. South Carolina has no provision for the incorporation of professional groups. The sole manner in which an organization offering professional services which require a license from a State Licensing Board may collectively practice such a profession or render such services in South Carolina is pursuant to those statutes governing Professional Associations.

I enclose a previous opinion of this Office dealing with the domestication of foreign professional corporations for your information.
