Dear Representative Howard:

In response to your request for an opinion from this Office as to whether or not the Greenville County Legislative Delegation recommends for appointment the members of the board of trustees of Stroud Memorial Hospital, my opinion is that the Delegation does so recommend the members for appointment pursuant to Act No. 1239 of 1964 [53 STAT. 2866 (1964)], as amended. The provisions of Act No. 283 of 1975, the 'home rule' legislation, have not effected a change in this authority and will not do so even after January 1, 1980, because the Stroud Memorial Hospital District is a special purpose district, the members of whose governing body are to continue to be recommended for appointment as the General Assembly sees fit pursuant to [Section 4-9-170, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA](#), 1976.
