Dear Mr. Trask:

You have asked what appropriate action an individual doing business in Cherokee Falls may take concerning improper maintenance of the local water and sewer system.

It is my understanding that the water and sewer system in Cherokee Falls is owned and operated by South Carolina Distributors, Inc., Herbert Livingston, President. Since the system is run by a public utility, as defined in [S.C. Code Ann. § 58-5-10\(3\) \(1976\)](#), rather than by a public service or special purpose district, the proper authority to bring a complaint before is the Public Service Commission. [§ 58-5-210, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA \(1976\)](#).

I hope this will sufficiently answer your question.
