Dear Mr. White:

The purpose of this letter is to advise you that, in my opinion, South Carolina law provides sufficient authority for the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control to issue National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permits to federal facilities within the State of South Carolina and to enforce such permits. The Department of Health and Environmental Control also has authority to impose upon such permittees monitoring and reporting requirements and to enter and inspect such facilities to insure compliance with their permit terms and conditions.
