Dear Mr. Kight:

This is to acknowledge receipt of and thank you for your letter of August 8, 1978, in regard to the illegal practice of accountancy by Mr. Fox and Mr. Cordray. I have reviewed the correspondence between the Board and Mr. Cook, attorney for Mr. Fox and Mr. Cordray, and I would agree with your finding that these individuals have violated the Accountancy Registration Law. Specifically, Mr. Fox has prepared income statements and balance sheets for various businesses and has signed these papers as an accountant. If Mr. Fox and Mr. Cordray refuse to voluntarily comply with the law, either by ceasing to practice accountancy or by becoming registered with the Board, the Board has the authority under [Section 40-1-350 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina \(1976\)](#), to seek an injunction in the Civil Court to prevent these individuals from further violating the State law. I would recommend that the Board review this case and determine if, as you and I believe, that these individuals have violated the Accountancy Registration Law and the Board's regulations. If they determine that such violations have occurred, they may request that our Office bring a legal action against these individuals to enjoin them from further acts and violations of law. I would be glad to assist the Board in any way I can in this regard.
