Dear Mr. Fleming:

Thank you for your letter of April 12, 1977, concerning the employment of a county attorney by Sumter County.

This is a matter in which the county governing body has full authority and in which I have no jurisdiction.

With respect to executive sessions of the governing body, I advise that the Freedom of Information Act permits executive sessions for certain stated purposes. If you have any question with respect to whether an executive session is improperly called, the Act provides only that the matter be resolved by court action. I suggest that you make your views known to the governing body and other members thereof.
