Dear Mrs. Aaron:

In 1970 the General Assembly passed an Act which required interest charges to payments made in restoring service. At the time that Mr. Gressette advised you that all you would need to pay was \$280.62, the 1970 changed law had not taken effect, nor did Mr. Gressette have any way of knowing what changes in the law might take place in the future. The statutory law in South Carolina is quite clear and the Retirement System has no alternative but to charge you the amount due plus interest in accordance with the enclosed statutory requirement.
