In reply to your letter concerning whether an oil tanker may park within the corporate limits of the Town of Williamston, there seems to be absolutely nothing in the Code of Laws of South Carolina (1962) on point under Title 16 'Crimes and Offenses', Title 32 'Health', or Title 33 'Highways, Bridges, and Ferries'.

As you know, however, § 47-61 Code of Laws of South Carolina confers the power upon municipal corporations to act for the public welfare. It would seem that this problem could therefore be dealt with from the local level.
