Dear Mr. Toomey:

This is in reply to your letter of March 10, 1975, concerning transportation of firearms through South Carolina.

As to carrying a firearm, your attention is directed to the enclosed statute Section 16-129.1, 1962 Code of Laws, as amended, and more particularly subsection (9) of the statute.

As to your Pennsylvania license to carry a firearm it has no force or effect in this State, however, there are no licensing requirements in this State, and one must follow the mandates of Section 16-129.1.

Also included is a copy of Section 16-145 dealing with carrying a concealed weapon.
