Dear Mr. Vanderford:

In my opinion, the establishment of Home Rule in implementation of the local government amendment would not have the effect of removing Chester County from the injunction issued by Judge Hayes in 1967. The injunction is directed against the County Board of Directors and their successors in office, and unless the County Attorney or other persons giving legal advice to the County feels otherwise, I would act on the assumption that it is binding upon the County until removed by the order of the court.
