You have requested that we advise you as to whether or not the County Council of Oconee County has the authority to require by ordinance that the offices of Auditor, Treasurer, Tax Collector, Supervisor, Probate Judge and Clerk of Court be open from 8:30 A.M., to 12:00 Noon on Saturdays.

Our review of the powers and duties possessed by the Council does not disclose that it has been vested with that authority by the General Assembly of South Carolina. See, 57 STAT. Act No. 555, Section 8 at 1049-1051 (1971).
