Dear Mr. Matthews:

Thank you for your letter of April 3, 1975, inquiring whether a County employee may serve as County Federal Coordinator and at the same time serve on the School Board.

In my opinion, the Federal Coordinator's job is an employment and not an office, based upon the information concerning this position which you have related to me. Therefore, the dual officeholding provision of the Constitution would not be violated by such an individual serving as a member of a School Board.
