Dear Mr. Thompson:

You have requested advice as to whether Section 1-11 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended by the 1974 Cum. Supp. applies to the Horry County board of education. This statute requires the filing with the Secretary of State of all rules and regulations adopted under authority of a general and permanent law of the State.

S. C. Code Ann. Section 21-3054 states that:

The Horry County board of education shall have the following duties and powers relative to the public schools in the county (1) To promulgate rules and regulations and adopt administrative policies for the efficient operation of the schools.

Section 21-3054 appears to be a general and permanent law of the State, and therefore the Horry County board of education must comply with Section 1-11 when it promulgates rules and regulations concerning the efficient operation of its schools.
