Dear Mr. Kleckley:

Your letter of April 22, which was received in this Office on April 25, requests my opinion as to whether legislation may be enacted to have the office of County Supervisor of Jasper County abolished.

It is my opinion that this legislation is clearly in conflict with the provisions of Article VIII, Section 7 of the Constitution of South Carolina, which prohibits the enactment of laws for a specific county.

I therefore am of the opinion that such legislation would be unconstitutional.
