Treasurer. Section 65-1951. The Treasurer is appointed by the Governor, subject to confirmation by the Senate.

Further research is necessary to establish the procedures creating the following Commissions. These will be reported to you as early as possible.

Central Midlands Regional Planning Council. Industrial Development Commission.
