Gentlemen:

Thank you very much for your letter of April 18 concerning some means of obtaining municipal incorporation.

All cities and towns in the State that are incorporated are governed by a city council or similar body. The procedure for incorporation is provided in the Code of Laws for this State.

It generally requires petition for incorporation describing the limits of the proposed town and a vote is thereafter held on the question of incorporation.

Cities and towns do receive State aid in various forms—form liquor monies, highway license fees, etc.
