Dear Officer Phillips:

This is in reply to your letter received May 5, 1975. You have inquired as to any legislation which would prohibit the use of the weapon 'nunchaku'.

As far as I am able to ascertain there is no legislation existing or presently pending which deals with this instrument. Were a prosecution to be commenced for the possession of such a weapon, it would most likely arise under the prohibitions of Section 16-145, 1962 Code of Laws, as amended.

I hope this will be of aid to you in your research.
