Dear Mr. Hathaway:

In reply to your letter of May 23 regarding certain aspects of the sale of beer and wine please find enclosed the relevant portions of Title 4, 1962 Code of Laws, as amended.

You have asked the following:

1. Minimum age of person who may sell it.

See Section 4-203.4.

2. Minimum age of persons who may purchase it.

See Section 4-203.

3. Maximum amount that can be purchased at one time.

No limitation.

4. Any limitations on hours or days it may be sold.

See Section 4-204. Also see Sections 4-205, 4-205.1, and 4-241 for regulations concerning certain counties. Local ordinances may regulate the hours during which beer and wine can be sold, so you will want to check with an attorney or local officials to ascertain what effect this has upon your business.
