Dear Judge Edenfield:

You have asked the opinion of this Office as to the proper charge to be made against a person who operates a motor vehicle while his license is suspended for failure to satisfy safety responsibility insurance or proof of financial responsibility requirements.

It is the opinion of this Office that a person who drives a motor vehicle while his license is suspended under the Safety Responsibility Act only would be in violation of Section 46-710, 1962 Code of Laws of South Carolina.
