Dear Mr. Hill:

Thank you for your letter of July 21 concerning your municipal problem. I regret you have difficulties in your town, but I believe that the Local Government Law which was adopted at the last session of the Legislature may bring about some solution.

That law will not become effective until 1976, but it does provide several alternative forms of government and other governmental changes. Consequently, I would suggest that this Local Government Law be looked at closely and that proper steps be taken to implement it between now and until changes of government are made under the new law. I am sending you a copy of that law for your convenience and the city section begins on page 26. I sincerely hope that you will find a means of achieving an early solution to your problem.
