

- A. Respondent PowerOne, every successor, affiliate, control person, agent, servant, and employee of Respondent PowerOne, and every entity owned, operated, or indirectly or directly controlled by or on behalf of Respondent PowerOne will **CEASE AND DESIST** from committing or causing any violations of the Act; and
- B. Respondent PowerOne will pay a civil penalty in the amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) to the Division.

Upon execution by the Commissioner, this Order resolves Administrative Proceeding 20166600 as to Respondent PowerOne Corporation.


The parties to this Consent Order agree that the Consent Order does not and should not be interpreted to waive any (i) criminal cause of action, (ii) private cause of action that may have accrued to any investor(s), (iii) action of any kind in any type of bankruptcy proceeding(s), or (iv) other causes of action which may result from any activity of Respondent PowerOne not detailed in the Order to Cease and Desist or which may hereafter arise.




