You have requested an opinion from this office as to whether or not the procedure used by the Town Council of the City of Walhalla to advertise for bids for the construction of Phase 2 of Project #45-00260 complies with South Carolina statutory notice provisions. It is the opinion of this office that the radio announcements and newspaper articles provided by the Walhalla City Council constituted sufficient notice. I have been unable to discover any statutory provisions that require the City of Walhalla to advertise for bids in printed form. Consequently, any manner of advertising that the City Council chooses, which provides general publication, is acceptable.
