You have requested that this Office advise you as to the method prescribed for the serving of subpoenas under the new judicial reform proceedings. The Judicial Reform Bill has not yet been passed by both Houses of the Legislature, therefore the subpoena procedure will be the same as previously followed under the provisions of Title 26 of the Code of Laws of South Carolina, 1962.
