To confirm our telephone conversation of April 15, 1974, there is no law which would prohibit a councilman from maintaining his office and at the same time offering as a candidate for mayor. Should he win the mayorship he would have to resign as councilman. This office thus becoming vacant, an election would have to be held to fill the vacancy.
