Mr. McKenzie referred to me your request for an opinion on the above proposed legislation as it relates to the authority of the Division of General Services to offer a package insurance plan for small hospitals, containing both Tort and Workmen's Compensation coverage. In my opinion, there is only statutory authorization for the State Fund to provide Workmen's Compensation coverage for government agencies, and this proposed legislation would in no way change this authority and responsibility for providing such coverage.
