Regarding the establishment by you of a correspondence school, you are advised that proprietary schools in South Carolina are regulated by the State Board of Education pursuant to the Proprietary School Act of 1971. See, CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA §§ 21-750 et seq. (Cumulative Supplement) (1962). Moreover, no business college, university or similar school may offer a degree of any kind without the Board's approval. CODE OF LAWS OF SOUTH CAROLINA § 21-671 (1962).

Additional questions concerning the establishment of a correspondence school should be directed to your attorney or to the State Board of Education.
