Thank you for your letter of recent date requesting the opinion of this Office on the legality of a school board's becoming a member of the South Carolina School Board Association.

Authorization for members of the board of trustees of any school district in this State to become a member of the South Carolina School Board Association and to have the fees and dues therefor paid by the school district is found in Act No. R-882, approved by the Governor January 23, 1974, a copy of which is herewith enclosed.

This is specific authority for the members of school boards to join the Association referred to and for payment of the necessary fees and dues for such membership paid by the school board.
