Dear Mr. Mendelsohn:

Thank you for your letter of August 22, 1974, in which you inquire as to the required number of signatures needed for a petition candidate for the House of Representatives. Section 7 of the Reapportionment Act states that a petition filed for the office of House of Representatives would require the signatures of one thousand registered electors. This requirement is set as an absolute requirement for a petition for the office of House of Representatives; therefore one thousand signatures would be a mandatory requirement for this petition.
